	The Race is planned for September 14th, 2024. It offers 3 running races: a 5k, 10k and half marathon. New in 2023 we added a mountain bike race as well. The starts times are: Half Marathon - 8:00am, MTB - 8:30am 10k - 9:00am, and 5k - 9:15am.					
	We are requesting approval to use the new Toll Ranch Trail this year to create more separation between our runners and mountain bikers. This new route would utilize all the same West Magnolia trails, Eldora Nordic Center trails and a small section of Jenny Creek Trail. Please see map link below.
